COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD FOR 2011

The FBI National Academy Associates Michigan Chapter will offer scholarships of \$2,500 to selected students for post-secondary education at an accredited College or University.

The intent of this program is to:

- Encourage an ongoing college education,
- Promote community involvement,
- Encourage active membership in the FBI National Academy Associates.

A maximum of three (3) scholarships will be funded every year and paid as follows: Freshman year \$250; sophomore year \$500; junior year \$750; senior year \$1,000.

To be eligible, students must be a son, daughter, step-child, or grandchild of an active member of the Michigan Chapter of the FBINAA.

The following requirements must be maintained to continue to receive the scholarship for 4 years. The student must:

- attend school full time, (a minimum of 12 credits)
- maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- the education must be continuous with the exception of summer break.

Only high school seniors are eligible to apply.

Students wanting to be considered must complete the attached nomination form. It must be postmarked no later than **May 1, 2011** and mailed to:
